Maona Coffeetable

An architectural statement

Inspired by the Japanese principle of “Ma” – the intentionally shaped void – this piece of furniture creates tension not through mass, but through balance. Flowing, organic lines meet clear geometry, translating architectural precision into a compact format.

Solid wood meets steel, mass meets lightness.
Maona stretches the space between sculpture and object.
The tables embody a living balance of tension and calm,
movement and pause. Lines open up, create distance, and
meet again.

The quiet center of the room

As a coffee table, Maona translates the formal DNA of the dining table series of the same name into a concentrated, smaller, almost intimate format, condensing it into a compact gesture—architecturally clear yet surprisingly fluid.

Here, too, the Japanese principle of “Ma” shapes the design. The precise gap between the curved steel side panels remains the central element: it structures the volume, guides light through the construction, and lends the compact body a tangible sense of lightness.

New is the amorphous tabletop. Its organically flowing contour defies strict geometry—without axis, without beginning, without end. The result is a field of tension between structural clarity and soft openness: structure and movement in dialogue.



Interspace and movement

In Maona, steel and solid wood do not appear as heavy, static bodies, but as a consciously composed unit. Materials traditionally associated with solidity free themselves from their weight and acquire a new, surprisingly light identity. With every perspective, their expression changes: the frame appears graphically clear yet in motion, the tabletop soft, flowing, organic. The result is a calm, effortless sense of dynamism. On the smaller scale of the coffee table, the idea of the series becomes more condensed. The construction remains precise, while the silhouette grows freer—almost mobile within the space.



The Maona coffee table can be configured according to individual preferences. The organic solid wood tabletop, featuring the distinctive Swiss edge, is available in five solid wood options: from natural or white-oiled oak to deeply brushed "Oak Black," the mineral-toned "Oak Meteor," and elegant American walnut.

The frame is available in two powder-coated finishes:
Indian Brown and Black Onyx.

Organic form in a functional context

With the Maona side table, the table series expands to include a compact, functional element for the living area. Designed as a slender standalone piece, it fits precisely between two sofa modules and enhances any arrangement with an additional surface.

Formally, the side table directly references the Maona coffee tables. Its amorphous tabletop adopts their softly flowing contour. It follows no rigid geometry, but instead develops a free, organic silhouette. Gently rounded edges reinforce this impression, giving the form a cohesive and calm appearance.

Crafted from 20 mm solid wood, the side table remains true to the series' material-conscious approach. Like all tables in the Maona series, it is available in the collection's characteristic solid wood finishes. The carefully coordinated material palette reflects the surfaces of the dining and coffee tables, ensuring a consistent design continuity throughout the series.





Maona Coffeetables:

A coffee table like an architectural statement. Organic, flowing lines meet geometric rigor and find their balance in a compact, harmonious form that subtly shifts depending on the perspective. Crafted from European solid wood, Maona expresses the warmth, depth, and authenticity of the natural material in a truly distinctive way.
