





The Disquo side table line is a decorative side furniture which fits into the most different ambience due to its aesthetic and independent look.


Single "disques" are unconventionally stacked on top of each other and, because of the wide range in materials and colours, create a dazzling ensemble.



Does it make music? The elemental forms of the stacked discs invoke a fun, maybe slightly naive, want to play. Cleverly combined materials and well balanced proportions however turn the playful composition into a sophisticated object, which thus loses its playful character.


Luckily, that doesn't mean that DISQUO takes itself too seriously. The design invites us to fantasise, to maybe even indulge in nostalgia. The disc shaped bodies of the tables invoke memories of records. Memories of a beat of a bygone era which we sometimes like to idolise.

In order for us to not dwell on the past for too long, DISQUO brings us back to the here and now with its eclectic composition. The lacquered elements are combined with shimmering metallic surfaces and a jazzy accent colour like coral or petrol. The tabletop is inlaid with oak, stained and then lacquered.

"A myriad of proportion models in a 1:1 scale were built in order to find the right dimensions. For that, I like to use classic construction paper. Depending on the thickness of the material, it is perfect to mild and shape.

But most of the time it's not enough for me to simply work on the 3D model. I get the urge to test the prototype as quickly as possible in different conditions, and see how it works in combination with other furniture."








